

Reclaim Your Dream Scholarship 2025 Program

The Reclaim Your Dream Scholarship Program is designed to provide tuition assistance to eligible students with a demonstrated desire to fulfil their academic dream. The criterion outlined below has been designed to give the Scholarship Awarding Committee maximum flexibility in awarding the scholarship. Recipients will be selected without regard to race, sex, color, creed, religious preference, age, national origin, or disability.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be awarded the scholarship, students must:

- have previously enrolled, did not start, and has decided to continue toward achieving their Welding dream by enrolling into an eligible StrataTech Education Group Welding program starting in June of 2025;
- re-enroll on or after May 16, 2025;
- enroll into a Welding program with at least 25 weeks of expected enrollment.
- be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident;
- complete the Tuition Planning process within 5 calendar days of enrollment;
- apply for and accept any applicable state, agency, and/or federal student aid (other than PLUS);
- have no lapse in proper registration or break in attendance and maintain an 80% overall attendance rate and graduate with a 3.0 Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA); and
- complete a Scholarship Request Form.

Awarding Process and Rules

- Prospective students who cancelled their enrollment prior to May 16, 2025, and students who have re-enrolled with an expected start date in June 2025 are eligible to apply.
- Students must apply for and accept all available agency, state, and/or federal student aid before requesting consideration for this scholarship program.
- Only one award will be given per student.
- Scholarships will be distributed incrementally over the entire duration of the student's 1st academic year.
- Scholarships are based on the enrolled student's start date. If a student changes their start date or shift, the scholarship award may be forfeited. Scholarships are not transferable or renewable and cannot be used in conjunction with any other institutional scholarship.
- Scholarship eligibility requires continuous enrollment. Termination from training will result in the loss of this scholarship.
- Scholarship amount will not exceed \$2,000.

Of the requests received, each will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. Of those eligible requests, the awards will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis and may not exceed \$2,000.
