

Level Up Scholarship Program

This scholarship program is designed to provide tuition assistance to those pursuing a higher level of education in Welding. The criterion outlined below has been designed to give the Scholarship Awarding Committee maximum flexibility in awarding the scholarship. Recipients will be selected without regard to race, sex, color, creed, religious preference, age, national origin, or disability.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be awarded the scholarship, students must:

- Enroll in the Associates of Occupational Studies in Welding Technology (AOSWT) or Associates in Applied Science in Welding Inspection and Quality Management (AASWI) at any StrataTech Education Group school after 9/16/2025 with an expected start date in September 2025
- Have a balance owed to Tulsa Welding School for their Professional Welder Program
- Demonstrate financial need as determined by the financial aid application process
- Complete a Level Up Scholarship Request Form;
- Have no lapse in proper registration; and
- Must meet all aspects of Satisfactory Academic Progress and graduate from the AOSWT/AASWI program.

Award Process and Rules

- Eligible Programs are the Associates of Occupational Studies in Welding Technology (AOSWT) or Associates in Applied Science in Welding Inspection and Quality Management (AASWI) Each student must complete a Level Up Scholarship Request Form.
- The maximum scholarship amount will not exceed \$5,000 of the prior balance.
- Scholarships will be distributed upon successful completion of the AASWI/AOSWT program to the Professional Welder program balance
- Scholarships are based on the enrolled student's start date. If a student changes their start date, the scholarship award may be forfeited.
- Scholarship eligibility requires continuous enrollment. Termination from training may result in the loss of this scholarship.
- Scholarships may be limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Students must achieve and maintain a 2.5 GPA and 80% attendance.
