

2024 High School Senior of Distinction Scholarship Program

All graduating High School seniors meeting the stated criteria will be eligible for consideration. The criteria have been designed to give the Scholarship Selection Committee maximum flexibility in awarding the scholarship. The recipient will be selected without regard to race, sex, color, creed, religious preference, age, national origin, or disability. The Scholarship Selection Committee will use the following criteria to award the Scholarship:

1. Must be a 2024 high school graduate.
2. Must have demonstrated scholastic achievement in high school with a maintained 2.0 or higher grade point average on a 4.0 scale. (Provide transcripts)
3. Must be a U. S. citizen or permanent resident.
4. Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the financial aid application process.
5. No lapse in proper registration or break in attendance will be allowed and Satisfactory Academic Progress must be maintained.
6. Scholarships are not transferable or renewable and will be distributed incrementally over the 1st Academic Year of the program for a maximum award of \$1,000.00.
7. Must provide a brief essay stating educational objectives, career goals, financial need, past and current extracurricular activities (community involvement) and how this scholarship will help you reach your goals.

The Scholarship Selection Committee will meet on July 31, 2024, review materials and award scholarships to eligible recipients whose scholarship materials were submitted prior to July 30, 2024. All materials must be submitted to scholarships@stratatech.com before this established deadline in order to be considered.

Each campus shall be awarded a total of only 10 scholarships per month for the months of July and August.

If a student changes his/her start date, his/her scholarship award may be forfeited.

The decision of the Scholarship Selection Committee will be final.
